SAN FRANCISCO PASSPORT AGENCY HOSTS PASSPORT DAY, SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 17, 2016

The San Francisco Passport Agency will open its doors on Saturday, September 17, from 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. for a special Passport Day. On Passport Day, no appointments are needed to apply for a passport, and customers can request routine or expedited service. Information on how to apply for a U.S. passport, including necessary documents and fees, is available at travel.state.gov. To reduce waiting times, customers are encouraged to complete applications online and bring completed, unsigned forms to the agency and come with passport photos that meet our guidelines.

U.S. citizens may also obtain passport information by phone, in English and Spanish, by calling the National Passport Information Center toll-free at 1-877-487-2778.
